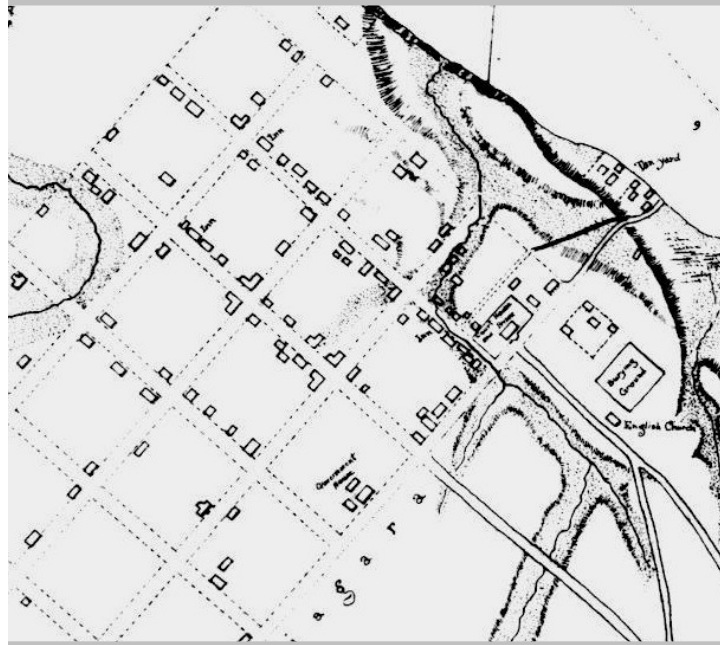


Niagara Historical Society & Museum presents

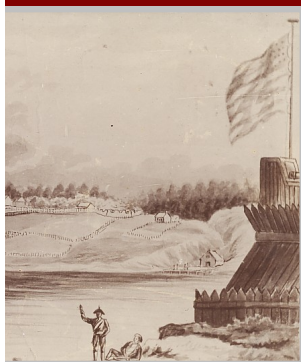
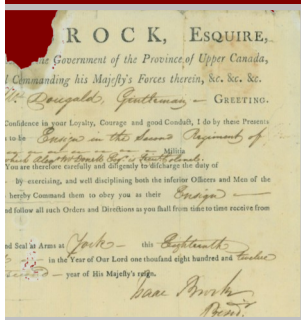
Tours start at the **Gazebo in Queen's Royal Park** at the end of King Street, and end at the Niagara Historical Museum on Castlereagh Street.
