Workshop: Creating a museum guide uniform

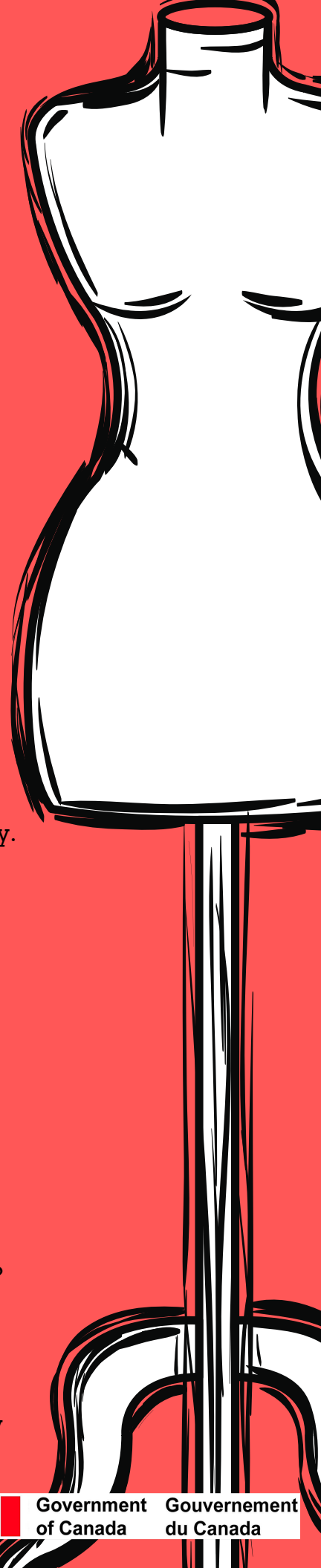
